

ITINERARY

10 Mar: Arrive Delhi

Upon arrival meeting at the Airport and transfer to the Hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

11 Mar: Leave: Delhi At: 1855 Hrs By: Flight

Arrive: Udaipur At: 2020 Hrs

After Breakfast visit Jama Masjid, Rickshaw Ride to visit Chandni Chowk, Humayun'b, India Gate & Parliament Building. Later transfer to Airport to connect Flight to Udaipur. Upon arrival meeting at the Airport and transfer to Hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

12 Mar: Udaipur

After Breakfast Start the Trek around 0945 Hrs and reach the first village in about half an hour where you have an interactive session with a few villagers & also visit their homes to see the lifestyle.

You will see the villager's doing daily chores & their cattle grazing in the fields around the village... We shall now continue our trek towards next tribal village, The Trek will be a mix of small hilly Terrain & Uphill climbs... on these treks, we will pass through various small villages and hamlets where we shall come across The Bhil Tribe (one of the oldest indigenous tribes) and a few other natives such as The old Warrior clan of The Rajputs who are mostly farmers now.

You arrive at finishing point... This place is a religious spot for the people around. There are a couple of temples here. One of them is dedicated to Lord Shiva and The other to The Mother Godess... from here one can get a panoramic view of the countryside.





13 Mar: Udaipur

After Breakfast enjoy the Festival of Colors Holi. Afternoon visit City Palace, Sheliyon Ki Bari, Jagdish Temple and Boat Ride on Lake Pichola. Overnight at Hotel.

14 Mar: Leave: Udaipur At: 0900 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Luni At: 1430 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Luni, En-route visit the famous Ranakpur Jain Temple. Upon arrival Check-In into Hotel. Pm walk around the Village to interact with Local People. Overnight at Hotel. (B)

15 Mar: Leave: Luni At: 1100 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Jodhpur At: 1230 Hrs

Early morning Jeep Safari to Bishnoi Village. After Breakfast leave for Jodhpur. Upon arrival Check-In into Hotel. Afternoon visit Mehrangarh Fort & Jaswant Thada. Pm enjoy Ziplining. Overnight at Hotel. (B)

Mehrangarh Fort: Mehrangarh Fort is one of the largest forts in India. Built around 1460 by Rao Jodha, the fort is situated 410 feet (125 m) above the city and is enclosed by imposing thick walls. Inside its boundaries there are several palaces known for their intricate carvings and expansive courtyards.



16 Mar: Leave: Jodhpur At: 0800 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Jaipur At: 1430 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Beautiful city Jaipur known as Pink City. Upon arrival Check-In into Hotel. Afternoon visit City Palace & Jantar Mantar. Overnight at Hotel. (B)

City Palace: City Palace, Jaipur, which includes the Chandra Mahal and Mubarak Mahal palaces and other buildings, is a palace complex in Jaipur, the capital of the Rajasthan state, India. The Chandra Mahal palace now houses a museum but the greatest part of it is still a royal residence. The palace complex, located northeast of the centre of the grid-patterned Jaipur city, incorporates an impressive and vast array of courtyards, gardens and buildings. The palace was built between 1729 and 1732, initially by Sawai Jai Singh II, the ruler of Amber.

Jantar Mantar: The Jantar Mantar monument of Jaipur, Rajasthan is a collection of nineteen architectural astronomical instruments, built by the Rajput king Sawai Jai Singh, and completed in 1738 CE. It features the world's largest stone sundial, and is a UNESCO World Heritage site.







17 Mar: Jaipur

After Breakfast Elephant Ride upto Amber Fort & Photo Stop at Hawa Mahal. Afternoon excursion to the fort of Bhangarh is amusingly said to be haunted, as it is surrounded by Jungle. It's a ruined fort situated on some height. There is a large open space / garden which attracts kids but to see the fort closely, you will have to do some steep climbing. The view from top is very good. On entrance, you will see the old used to be shops of the inhabitants along with few temples including Hanuman temple at the entrance. The road to this place is pathetic. People say, they hear different voices in night. Bahangarh is a must visit place. Later drive back to Jaipur. Overnight at Hotel.

Pm visit Local Market. Overnight at Hotel. (B)

Amber Fort: Amer Fort is located in Amer, a town with an area of 4 square kilometers located 11 kilometres from Jaipur. Rajasthan state, India. Located high on a hill, it is the principal tourist attraction in the Jaipur area. The town of Amer was originally built by Meenas and later it was ruled by Raja Man Singh I. Amer Fort is known for its artistic Hindu style elements. With its large ramparts and series of gates and cobbled paths, the fort overlooks Maota Lake. It is the main source of water for the Amer palace.

Hawa Mahal: Hawa Mahal (Palace of Winds or Palace of the Breeze) is a palace in Jaipur, India, so named because it was essentially a high screen wall built so the women of the royal household could observe street festivals while unseen from the outside. Constructed of red and pink sandstone, the palace sits on the edge of the City Palace, and extends to the zenana, or women's chambers.

18 Mar: Leave: Jaipur At: 0800 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Ranthambhore At: 1330 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Ranthambhore which has one of finest National Park in India, En-route visit Abhaneri Stepwell. Upon arrival check-in into Hotel. Afternoon enjoy Canter Safari into Ranthambhore National Park. Dinner & Overnight at Hotel. (B, D)



Ranthambhore: Ranthambore National Park or Ranthambhore is one of the largest national parks in northernIndia.

Ranthambore National Park lies at the edge of a plateau and is bounded to the north by the Banas River and to the south by the Chambal River. It is named after the historic Ranthambhore fortress, which lies within the park.

Ranthambore wildlife sanctuary is known for its Tigers and is one of the best places in India to see these Animals in their natural jungle habitat.

19 Mar: Ranthambhore

Early morning Csnter Safari into Ranthambhore National Park. After safari abck to Hotel. After Breakfast morning at leisure. After Lunch Canter Safari into Ranthambhore National park. Dnner & Overnight at Hotel. (B, D)







20 Mar: Leave: Ranthambhore At: 0700 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Agra At: 1500 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Agra, En-route visit Fatehpur Sikri. Upon arrival Check-In into Hotel. Afternoon visit Agra Fort and Pm Taj Mahal by Sunset. Overnight at the Hotel. (B)



Taj Mahal: The Taj Mahal is an ivory-white marble mausoleum on the south bank of the Yamuna river in the Indian city of Agra. It was commissioned in 1632 by the Mughal emperor, Shah Jahan (reigned 1628–1658), to house the tomb of his favorite wife, Mumtaz Mahal. The tomb is the centrepiece of a 42-acre complex, which includes a mosque and a guest house, and is set in formal gardens bounded on three sides by a crenellated wall.

Agra Fort: The Agra Fort is a UNESCO World Heritage site located in Agra, Uttar Pradesh, India. It is about 2.5 km northwest of its more famous sister monument, the Taj Mahal. The fort can be more accurately described as a walled city. The present-day structure was built by the Mughals, though a fort had stood there since at least the 11th century. Agra Fort was originally a brick fort known as Badalgarh, held by Raja Badal Singh Hindu Sikarwar Rajput king (c. 1475). It was mentioned for the first time in 1080 AD when a Ghaznavide force captured it. Sikandar Lodi (1488–1517) was the first Sultan of Delhi who shifted to Agra and lived in the fort.

Arrive: Kathmandu At: 1440 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Delhi Airport to connect Flight to Kathmandu. Upon arrival meeting at the Airport and transfer to Hotel. Pm visit Pashupatinath Temple. Overnight at Hotel. (B)

22 Mar: Leave: Kathmandu At: 0800 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Chitwan At: 1300 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Chitwan. Upon arrival Check-In into Hotel. After Lunch enjoy Jungle Activities. Dinner & Overnight at Hotel. (B, L, D)

23 Mar: Chitwan

After Breakfast full day enjoy Jungle Activies followed with Elephant Safari into Chitwan National Park. Lunch, Dinner & Overnight at Hotel. (B,L,D)







24 Mar: Leave: Chitwan At: 0800 Hrs By: Surface

Arrive: Namo Budhha At: 1300 Hrs

After Breakfast leave for Namo Budhha, Upon arrival at Dhulikhel have a panoramic view of Himalayas from Karyolung in east to Himalchuli in the west. Later start Hiking from Dhulikhel to Namo Budhha Monastery through Kali Temand Kavre Village. Upon arrival Check-In into Monastery. Pm enjoy the visit of Monastery. Overnight at Monastery. (B, L, D)

25 Mar: Leave: Namo Budhha At: 0900 Hrs By: Hike

Arrive: Balthali Village At: 1200 Hrs

After Breakfast start Hiking to Balthali Village for approx 3 Hours. Upon arrival Check-In into Resort. Afternoon enjoy the visit of Village where you can see the Typical Nepali Village which includes the typical Tamang, Overnight at Hotel. (B, D)

VISA: INDIA - Visa required. Passengers who enter India only once require a single entry visa. India has recently introduced an online visa application process which will make it easier for passengers who need a single entry visa. Passengers may complete their application online for a \$60 fee at https://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/tvoa.html.

This applies to SINGLE ENTRY passengers only. This is a 2-STEP PROCESS:

- 1) Travelers complete an online form, upload a scanned passport photo and a scanned image of the passport information page, and receive initial approval in advance of travel.
- 2) Upon arrival in India the traveler must wait in line at the airport visa on arrival facility to secure the visa. Passengers, who enter India, continue to Nepal, and then re-enter India will require a double entry visa for India. To obtain a double entry visa, passengers may visithttps://indianvisaonline.gov.in/visa/. Passengers traveling to India will need to provide a reference, including name, address, and phone number, for their Indian visa. Two days following your initial booking and deposit, you will receive complete information via email about obtaining a visa to India. Visa applications should be submitted as early as possible as visa processing may require as long as 30 days.
